- 1. Updates/Concerns from Health and Safety Committee We reviewed the rational for the decision to switch from Virex to Oxivir for disinfecting between classes. Oxivir is safer for handling by students and has a shorter "dwell" time to achieve the desired level of disinfection.
- 2. Updates/Concerns from MSD/SNS Most of the waivers requested for adjustments to meal service methodology have been approved. We will be able to structure the meals bus routes to try and ensure the best access for families we know would not be able to come to school to pick up their meal on their online school days. As of today, the request to extend the summer meals program through the soft closure has not been approved.
- 3. Updates/Concerns from MSD Transportation As of today, the Transportation Department has only received 105 responses regarding ridership for the upcoming school year. Normal daily ridership is ~ 700, so they are working with the Communications group to find additional method for requesting families to call the Transportation Department. Paper notices have been sent out with summer meals and will be sent out that way again later this week.
- 4. Updates/Concerns from MSD Facilities We reviewed the cleaning protocol that will be followed on Wednesdays and Fridays: custodians will clean and disinfect all high touch surfaces in addition to their normal classroom/bathroom/hallway trash removal and floor cleaning. Day and night custodial work schedules will be adjusted as necessary if students are in the buildings on Wednesdays during short weeks. Training for teachers in the use of Oxivir will be provided via email and directly from their building custodians.
