## Agenda and Notes

- 1. Supply update To date, 9 lab coats have been donated and will be distributed to "high need" District personnel (nurses, SpEd staff, office personnel expected to deal with sick students. Per school nurse Amy Conway, any "oversize" clothing that will cover an employee's regular work clothes will suffice as a protective smock as long as it has long sleeves and drops down below an employees waist. 32-oz spray bottles need for the Oxivir in classrooms are on back order. We will need to order additional face shields for use by office personnel and others handling sick students. Frank will order 30 more.
- 2. Transportation The Transportation Department has only had contacts from 200 families. Normal ridership is between 670-700 riders on both the a.m. and p.m. routes. Charlie will; ask Dr. Bailey to send out another contact request via School Messenger. Greg Harris noted that we will try to have assigned seating on buses and that we will use video when we need to confirm "direct contact" should one of our bus riding students report a positive Covid test. We will follow District and local CDC protocols should this occur. Rachel asked about students transferring between buses and the potential for additional exposure. Greg noted that we will do everything we can to minimize transfers, but we are severely limited with drop space and conditions at both Lena and Russell.
- 3. Meals MSD has been granted a 2-week extension on our summer meals program. This will be staffed by regular MSD cooks and will continue through Friday, 9.11.2020. Kendra and Charlie continue to work with admins to fine tune meal service plans in each building and to complete hiring for vacant positions. It is possible that the one or more MSD kitchens may not be staffed, and meals for those buildings would need to be prepared in another school kitchen.
- 4. Draft Operations Plans we reviewed the DRAFT Operations plans for Transportation, Student Nutrition and Facilities. Suggested changes will be added to these plans and Charlie will upload them for review by the Oversight Committee.
