Protocol

Current Changes

Classroom Spacing Issues

- Eliminate: Three-foot target distance requirement within classrooms.
- Approve: Carpet time/Table time with class/groups together for learning activities.
- Snack time returns to classrooms.
- Approve: Class pictures together (not composite).
- Approve: Student gatherings/assemblies.

Contact Tracing:

- No formal monitoring of cases within classroom.
- Notify whole classes of multiple positive case in room at elementary.
- Eliminate: Requirement for current seating charts filed in office.

Mixed Grouping Issues

- Approve Mixed grouping between classes (Title I, Intervention Groups, Leveling, etc.)
- Approve: Mixed groupings within classes.
- Eliminate: Coordinated seating charts between classes.
- Approve: After school/during school activities.
- Lunchroom spacing and seating- keep students grouped by class but shorten distances.
- KN95/N95 masks provided when available.
- Allow: Full School Assemblies when in low category
- Allow: Indoor events with large parent groups when in low category.
- Eliminate: lunchroom dividers.

Facilities and Materials:

- Eliminate: Library Book quarantine.
- Water fountains or bottle stations- Open drinking fountains, number.
- Approve: Field Trips to indoor facilities.
- Clean/Disinfect classroom surfaces as needed.
- Have available hand sanitizer/access to hand washing between class and recess transitions.
- Encourage hand washing.

Staff/Adults:

- Continue with no mask monitoring, masks will be available in the office.
- Staff gatherings in lunchroom/after school- as staff are comfortable.
- Eliminate: Meetings of 10 and over staff rule requiring masks.
- Teach kids courtesy and respect with masks.
- Reteach hygiene (covering mouth).
- Approve: Classroom volunteers and mentors.
- Conferences- limit number of families at a time. Give options for remote.
- Eliminate: No guests during student lunches.
- No home prepared food for classes/groups.
- Snacks for distribution to students must be individually wrapped or passed out by a gloved staff member.
